(LEVEL 8) MONTESSORI EDUCATION

Overview

This B.Ed (Hons) in Montessori Education provides learners with a strong understanding of Montessori philosophy and practice as applied to early years education for the child aged birth to 9 and on to age 12 (Level 8 only). Garda vetting is mandatory.

Entry Requirements

Leaving Certificate - H5 in two higher level subjects plus minimum of four 06s in ordinary level subjects to include english and maths, or other equivalent level 5 award. Entry is subject to full Garda vetting.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION

(LEVEL 7) MONTESSORI EDUCATION

Overview

This programme is for educators who wish to embark on a career working with children in early years setting and Montessori environments up to age 9. The Level 7 programme represents the first 3 years of the Level 8 programme however, students may apply to transfer to the Level 8 Programme at the end of these 3 years. Garda vetting is mandatory.

Duration: 3 Years F/T & P/T


