Guidelines during Open Book Examinations and Online Assessment:

Learners with Special Considerations for examinations will still be allowed to avail of these considerations for Open Book Examinations and online assessment.

How will it work?

- Learners will receive allowances for spelling, grammar and punctuation as before.
- Learners who require a **READER** will be allowed have a member of their 'household group' assist in reading questions when needed. Please note the household member may assist in reading questions only, they may not assist in answering questions.
- Learners who require a **SCRIBE** will be allowed have a member of their 'household group' assist in typing an assignment if needed. Please note the household member **may** assist in typing only, they **may not assist** in answering questions.

Note: The **READER** and the **SCRIBE** may be the same person.

Multiple Choice Question Exams: When a learner is completing an MCQ, where a typed
answer is required please note that a spelling error may lead to an incorrect initial
overall mark for this assignment. This mark is provisional only and any correct answers
with incorrect spelling will have the mark corrected when the assignment is reviewed by
the lecturer.
