Overview

This B.Ed. (Hons) in Montessori Education provides learners with a strong understanding of Montessori philosophy and practice as applied to early years education for the child aged birth to 9 and on to age 12 (via electives in year 4). Garda vetting is mandatory.

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION

(LEVEL 7) MONTESSORI EDUCATION (EARLY YEARS)

Overview

This programme is for educators who wish to embark on a career working with children in early years setting and Montessori environments up to age 9. The Level 7 programme represents the first 3 years of the Level 8 programme however, students may apply to transfer to the Level 8 Programme at the end of these 3 years. Garda vetting is mandatory.


